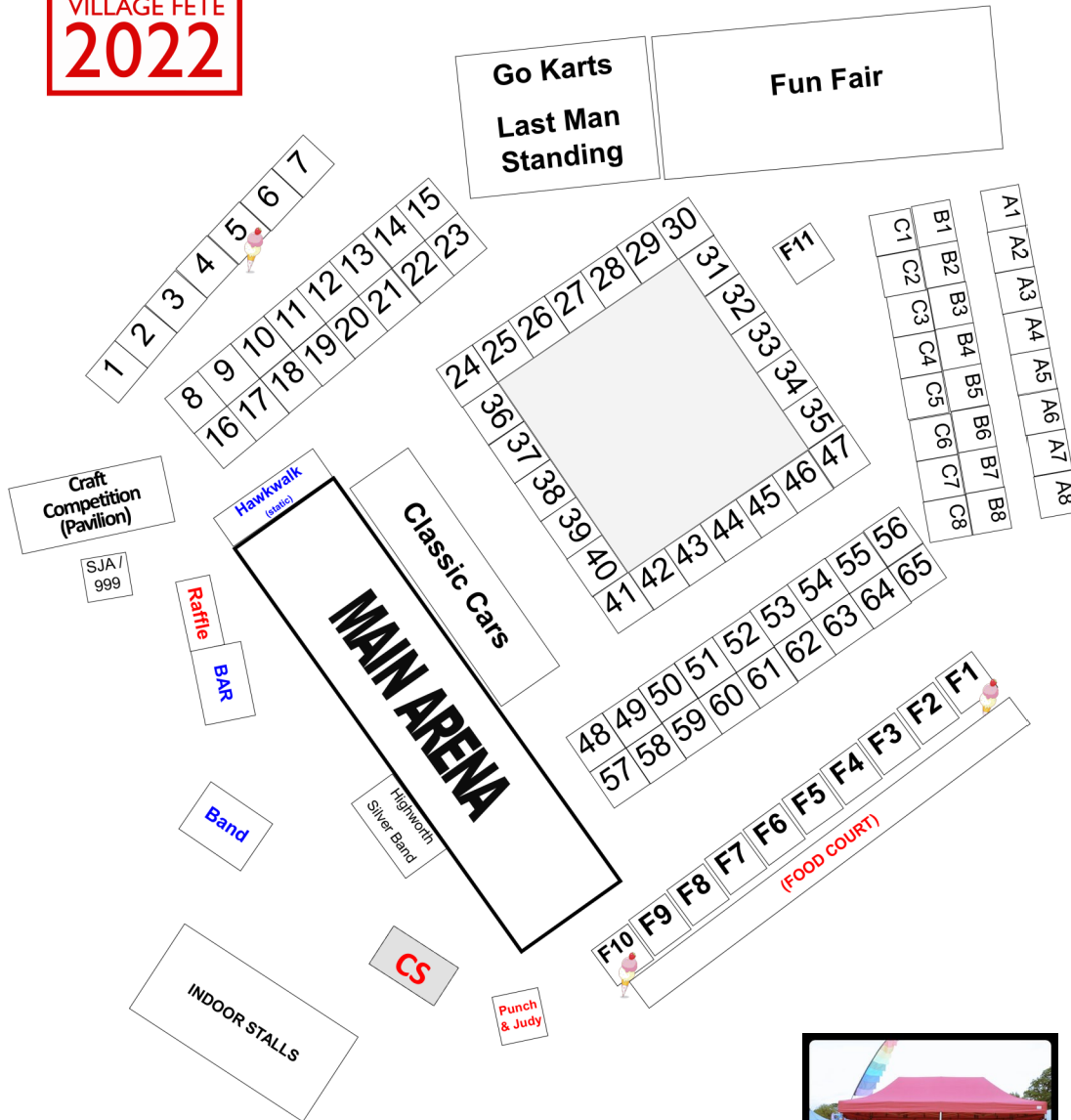
The Fete Committee team will be on hand to advise and help you throughout the day and my sincere thanks go to them and to all of the helpers that get stuck in on the day and make it all happen!
